On behalf of my people I have the honour to most humbly approach you seeking your permission to send to, and have signed by the Aborigines population under your charge, the undermentioned petition, a copy of which is to be forwarded to His Majesty King George V of England, asking on our behalf to do his utmost in taking suitable steps in preventing the extinction of the Aboriginal Race.

- 1. Obtaining better conditions for all.
- 2. Obtaining power to propose a Member of Parliament to be chosen by my people to represent us in the Federal Parliament.
