In an attempt to form a council to coordinate the efforts of aboriginal welfare workers, the Australian Aborigines' League has called a meeting of representatives of betterment societies and friends for tomorrow night at 8 at the Society of Friends Hall, Russell Street. Education of aborigines will be discussed, and the following motion will be put to the meeting:— "That full educational facilities be given aborigines with a view to their emancipation and uplift". The League has a branch in every State and a membership of aborigines. It is believed that a council of the type envisaged would act as a "spearhead" of interested societies, but would not affect their domestic arrangements.
