To assist a needy half-caste family, an aboriginal concert will be held at the South Melbourne Town Hall on Thursday, at 8 p.m. The father of the family was recently killed while going to work, and one of his sons, who was travelling with him, was so seriously injured that his arm had to be amputated. The widow has nine children, only three of whom are earning. The youngest is three months old. The concert is being organised by the Australian Aborigines' League. Several successful concerts have already been given by the aboriginal choir, the gumleaf quartet, and other aboriginal entertainers, including Doug Nicholls, the Fitzroy footballer.
